Staff introduced the project, and informed the <u>Design Professional's Review for Historic Preservation</u> was outsourced to Corky Poster, since the City's Historic Preservation Officer position is currently vacant and

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Chair Gonzalez was not available for the historic preservation portion of the review. The Design Professional provided remarks. The applicant presented the project to the MGD-DRC, providing the following clarifications in response the questions posed by the MGD-DRC:

- a) The bioswale that has been in design for many years, prior to this project becoming a concept; now that developer has 100% plans in hand, they are more than happy to integrate the plans for the bioswale into their onsite plans and are committed to moving forward on it; will keep MGD-DRC Member Williams up to date on the discharge review process;
- b) The MGD document amendment that was approved by the Mayor and Council was to add the new Section D.5 to modify height requirements, with the 24-foot-high edge along Euclid Avenue, then steps to 48 and then 73 feet to the east; the amendment is now being implemented through this MGD review process; and
- c) Agreement with the West University Neighborhood has been funded and fulfilled 100%; working with the City of Tucson to deploy those funds to provide sidewalks in much of the neighborhood.

Staff also provided the following clarification to the MGD-DRC:

a) Pima County and City's Planning & Development Services Engineering are determining the capacity for the project's expected discharge of water used for flushing fire systems, pool and cleaning of decks, but there is a commitment via this project that affluent sources will not be discharged into the storm water system.

A motion was made by MGD-DRC Member Warne, with note of confirmation of items brought up by MGD-DRC Member Williams related to discharge of affluent sources. Motion was duly seconded by MGD-DRC Member Currans. Motion passed 4-0, with MGD-DRC Member Huber abstaining.

The City Manager appointment Ms. Kelly Huber, the new Executive Director for the Marshall Foundation, as a member of the MGD-DRC, replacing Ms. Ryland.
